Model Apartment Housing located at 116–120 West 129th Street was constructed in 1883 and currently serves as an apartment building. Model Apartment Housing is designed in the Queen Anne architectural style, characterized by contrasting facade materials, colors, and textures, and small protruding curved bay windows. The five-story tall building has varying exterior materials between its first and upper stories. The first story is visible as rough-cut beige stone in varying sizes, while the upper stories are red brick. The minimally protruding bay windows range from the second to fourth stories and curve on its angles to create an organic additional mass to the building.
